INFRINGEMENT NOTICE

An Infringement Notice has been issued to the company registered as the owner of the vehicle identified in an alleged offence. In compliance with the Road Safety Act 1986 Part 6AA – Operator onus, the company may complete the attached Nomination Statement.

If you nominate the responsible person and the nomination is accepted, that person will become liable for the offence and the notice against the company will be withdrawn. The penalty payable by the responsible person may be significantly lower than the penalty specified on the current Infringement Notice.

Failure by the company to nominate or give an effective statement in relation to three or more Infringement Notices (for offences that incur demerit points) served within a 12 month period, may result in a fine in excess of \$18,000 regardless of payment status.

PENALTY REMINDER NOTICE

If you do not pay the amount outstanding, or take one of the options outlined on the front of your notice by the due date, further enforcement action will be taken and added fees will be incurred under the Fines Reform Act 2014.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Nomination is not an option once a Notice of Final Demand is issued.

NOTICE OF FINAL DEMAND

If you do not pay the outstanding amount (including added fees), or use the other options to finalise the matter, a Notice of Final Demand will be issued.

If you do not finalise the matter by the due date, the Director, Fines Victoria may take one or more of the following enforcement actions:

- suspend the company's vehicle registration(s)
- prevent the company from transferring or renewing a vehicle registration
- prevent the company from registering a vehicle
- make deduction(s) from the company's bank account or money owed
- charge and sell the company's land
- commence proceedings under Corporations Law.

The Director may also apply to the Magistrates' Court to issue an Enforcement Warrant.

ENFORCEMENT WARRANT

If an Enforcement Warrant is issued, an Enforcement Warrant fee will be added to your outstanding amount.

If you do not pay the full amount (including the added fees) or you do not use your other options to finalise the matter, the Sheriff has the power to:

- seize and sell the company's property
- wheel clamp the company's vehicle
- remove the number plates of the company's vehicle, and the Director, Fines Victoria may suspend the registration of that vehicle.
